Dearly Loved by Christ,

***“Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.” (John 16:24)***

I listened to a sermon the other day and the minister preached on what would have happened if King David had called for his chariot rather than calling for Bathsheba. He pointed out that sometimes after several years of ministry, we grow weary and want to just start taking life easy. I can relate. I turn 60 this month and had been having those exact thoughts—until I heard this sermon. I don't want to call for ease and comfort—I want to call for the chariots! And I need for you to call for them with me. Together we can extend the rule of the Kingdom in ways we would never have imagined!
