Dearly Loved by Christ,

Genesis 1:26, "Then God said, 'Let us make man in our own image...'"

Genesis 3:4, "But the serpent said, '...you will be like God...'"

Not too long ago I shared these two scriptures with someone who is desperately seeking an image—a way to be defined and known. I told this person that Satan hated it that God has made us to bear His image, so he offered Adam and Eve another image—the image of Self. They believed the lie and accepted his offer. The sad thing is before they sinned all they could see was God's image in each other, now Self was all they could see. So they made coverings for themselves out of fig leaves because Self must decide what others see. Self must make its own image. So we choose our fig leaf and we hide behind it.

Beloved, image bearing is so much more than how others see us. It involves being under the rule of the one whose image we bear. In the same way that Jesus told the Pharisees to give to Caesar what is Caesar's because of his image on the coin, we are to give to God what is His because we bear His image. Only the power of the gospel restores us to our God-bearing image. Only the power of the gospel empowers us to submit to bearing God's image. Only the power of the gospel takes us out of hiding. Only the power of the gospel produces this: ***"And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another."*** (2 Corinthians 3:18)

Remember this, God made us in His image, and He wants us back!
